Ed worked for almost 30 years in the Historic Resources branch of the Provincial Government and continues to work as a consultant since his retirement.

Ed was the principal researcher for a 2011 Prairie Public Broadcasting documentary called Steamboats on the Red – a Story of Buccaneers and Robber Barons.

Ed helped initiate and served as one of three project managers for a non-government heritage grant program for “country churches” and “rural icons”. He planned and implemented motor coach tours of natural and heritage sites in Manitoba.
